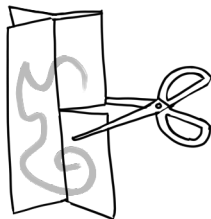

Fold and Cut

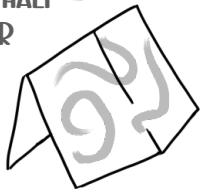
CREASE IN HALF –
HOTDOG



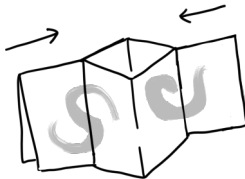
FOLD HAMBURGER,

TO CREASE



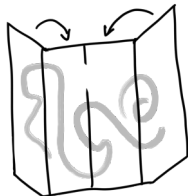
CREASE IN HALF –

WRITING ON INSIDE

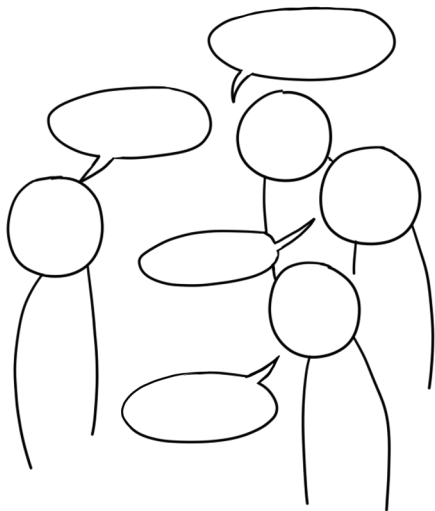
FOLD AROUND
INTO BOOK


