Immigrants are among the most vulnerable people in the United States:

**They are the most surveilled,
Most exploited for their labor,
Most at the mercy of the
government's decisions.**

Immigrants are a test-bed for surveillance, registries, and other forms control.

What they perfect on immigrants gets deployed on the rest of us.
